

## UPDATED ENTRY RESTRICTIONS TO PREVENT AN IMPORT OF OMICRON CORONAVIRUS VARIANT TO ROK (00:00am 03 DEC – 23:59pm 16 DEC 2021)

- \*\* Passengers who intend to transit through Incheon International Airport with no immigration pass into ROK are not permitted on board as well.
  - Foreign nationals with A-1, A-2, and long-term stay visas are permitted to board. Only those with A-1 and A-2 visas are exempted from mandatory quarantine upon arrival.
  - Only incoming travelers carrying quarantine exemption certificate issued for unvaccinated travelers in accordance with stricter standards are exempted from mandatory quarantine. Korean nationals holding diplomatic or official passport can be exempted from quarantine when they carry an exemption quarantine certificate as well.
    - While the already-issued quarantine exemption certificate is recognized, certificates issued for fully vaccinated overseas for visiting immediate family purposes are suspended.
    - Fully overseas vaccinated travelers holding pre-issued quarantine exemption certificate must undergo COVID-19 PCR test at the public health center under the jurisdiction of their residential address and wait at their accommodations for the result. Unvaccinated travelers holding pre-issued quarantine exemption certificate must undergo COVID-19 PCR test at temporary living facility and wait at the facility for the result.
  - Incoming travelers holding quarantine exemption certificate issued for unvaccinated travelers can be released from quarantine only after their COVID-19 PCR test result they undergo upon arrival at a temporary living facility designated by KDCA proves negative. In case a traveler tests positive, the traveler is transferred to a medical facility for treatment.

## **O** Health guidelines for flight/cabin crew:

It is recommended to replace flight/cabin crew who have been to one of nine African countries, whose list is above, for duties in the past 14 days with substitutes. When entering ROK, crew members with symptoms must undergo COVID-19 PCR test at the COVID-19 testing center at Incheon International Airport and those with no symptoms undergo an on-arrival COVID-19 PCR test at a temporary living facility designated by KDCA. Those whose test result proves to be negative move to their accommodations for layover taking transportations provided by their own airlines and those whose test result shows positive are transferred to medical facility for treatment.

\* Common requirement: All incoming travelers must undergo a COVID-19 PCR test at a temporary living facility designated by KDCA near Incheon International Airport upon arrival. Travelers whose test result proves negative follow the process specified in the above table and those who tested positive are transferred to a medical facility for treatment.

Korean nationals holding diplomatic or official passport can be exempted from quarantine when they carry an exemption quarantine certificate as well.

  - Fully overseas vaccinated travelers holding pre-issued quarantine exemption certificate must undergo COVID-19 PCR test at the public health center under the jurisdiction of their residential address and wait at their accommodations for the result. Unvaccinated travelers holding pre-issued quarantine exemption certificate must undergo COVID-19 PCR test at temporary living facility and wait at the facility for the result.
