

## All-out Support for Stabilizing the Jamboree Site

MOLIT is making its all-out support for the stability of the Jamboree site, providing 100 air-conditioned coaches and 15 specialized vehicles for refrigerated and frozen stuff, as well as additional on-site cleaning staff (total of 600 people), etc. while arranging more tourism programs, and so forth.

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport (MOLIT, Minister WON Hee-ryong) is on the active support to resolve the on-site issues of the Saemangeum World Jamboree while reviewing additional programs.

In accordance with the Presidential Directive (4 August) as "Provide an unlimited supply of air-conditioned coaches where the scouts can stay cool even for a while, as well as specialized vehicles that can supply cold bottled water, etc.", the MOLIT provided 100 air-conditioned large buses and 15 vehicles for cold and frozen stuff, requested by the Organizing Committee, with urgent securing and supplying to the event site.

Moreover, in order to improve sanitary conditions at the site, a total of 350 onsite cleaning workers has been added as of 6 August (total of 600 by the end of the event) with the cooperation of the construction industry as well as the Saemangeum Development and Investment Agency and the Regional Office of

Construction and Management in Iksan, and also with facility management experts to quick respond to solving problems such as toilet breakdowns, etc.

In addition, in line with the Presidential Directive (5 August) to "promptly add more tourism programs for the participating Jamboree scouts to help them note Korea's industry, culture, history and nature", domestic traveling by tourist trains through Korea Rail Road Corporation and other railway-related tours such as Seomjin River Train Village in Gokseong and RailBike in Jeongseon, etc. have been being reviewed.

Meanwhile, as Korean construction companies getting support for their entry into overseas market while the second booming in the Middle East in full swing, the related construction associations decided to raise further funds based on consultation with the organizing committee to provide additional items needed by participants from around the world.

MOLIT Minister Won stated, "We will continue to provide air-conditioned coaches and on-site staff, and so on until the Jamboree site gets fully stable.", and "In particular, MOLIT and related organizations keep active support for the future generations from various countries to Korea to participate in the Jamboree so that they can further strengthen trust and friendship".
