



Smart GEO Expo 2023 for Digital Korea

- The Smart GEO Expo 2023 will be taking place from November 8th for 3 days to showcase the field of spatial information by promoting exhibitions, conferences, and participating programs, etc.

- Marking its 15th anniversary, this year's Expo is expected to attract a record number of participants up to 13,000 in various events with 135 companies & organizations and 38 conferences

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport (MOLIT, Minister WON Hee-ryong) will hold the 「Smart GEO Expo 2023」 for three days starting from Wed. 8 November at KINTEX in Goyang, Gyeonggi-do to provide a glimpse into the future created by spatial information technology, which is the core foundation of the digital economy.

The Smart Land Expo, which is celebrating its 15th anniversary this year, is Asia's largest geospatial information exchange and cooperation platform where major figures and experts related to domestic and foreign geospatial information gather together.

This year's Expo will be held under the theme of "Digital Earth: Better Life for All" with various programs, including opening ceremony, exhibitions, conferences, business meetings, and support for job and start-up, etc.



There will be 135 companies and organizations related to spatial information participated this year, including Kakao, SK Telecom, Epic Games, Ministry of the Interior and Safety, and Korea Expressway Corporation, and more, making it the largest event ever.

In addition, a total of 38 conferences will be held at this time, and more than 200 world-class scholars and corporate officials in the field of geospatial information will appear as lecturers.

Moreover, around 100 overseas figures in the field of geospatial information from 20 countries will conduct business presentations, new technology showcases, business meetings, and workshops for domestic companies, and there also will be various programs such as Job Concert and GEO Golden Bell for future manpower in geospatial information.

Vice Minister for Land and Infrastructure KIM Oh-jin of the MOLIT stated, "We hope people can vividly experience the future digital world created by geospatial information innovative technologies at this event, where leading domestic and foreign geospatial information companies and experts participate.", adding, "It is expected to be an opportunity to revitalize the geospatial information industry by building overseas expansion capabilities through the establishment of a geospatial information global network".
